In February 2016, L. Scott Askins joined Kabbage, Inc., the leading technology and data platform powering automated lending, as its General Counsel and Secretary. In early 1996, she worked on her first IPO as outside counsel for Premiere Global Services, Inc. (PGi), the world's largest dedicated provider of collaboration software and services.

Ms. Askins' area of practice and specialty as an associate at Alston & Bird, LLP and Nelson Mullins Riley & Scarborough, LLP was corporate finance transactions, including IPOs and M&A, with a focus on communications, technology and healthcare. In early 1998, she went in-house

with WebMD Corporation, the leading provider of health information services, serving as its Vice President, Assistant General Counsel and Assistant Secretary, where her duties included WebMD's IPO filing and strategic transactions valued at an aggregate of approximately \$12.4 billion completed in less than one and a half years.

In late 2001, Ms. Askins joined PGi initially as a consultant in its Strategic Development Group and then as EVP – Legal, General Counsel and Corporate Secretary. During her tenure at PGi, Ms. Askins completed more than 30 strategic acquisitions and investments valued in aggregate at over \$525 million, as well as the divestiture of PGi's non-core messaging business for approximately \$105 million in 2010. In December 2015, Ms. Askins played a critical role brokering a go private deal with private equity firm, Siris Capital Group, LLC, in a transaction valued at approximately \$1 billion. Apart from her deep corporate experience, Ms. Askins' also oversaw a legal services department that supported the global business and the contract needs of more than 700 direct sales representatives in 25 countries servicing nearly 50,000 enterprise customers, including 75% of the Fortune 100.

She holds a Bachelor of Science degree in financial management from Clemson University, a JD from the University of South Carolina School of Law and a Master of Laws in Taxation from New York University School of Law.
