Marvin Lim, 35, is a civil rights attorney and Democratic candidate for State Representative, House District 99 (unincorporated Norcross/Lilburn). He is an attorney for the Giffords Law Center to Prevent Gun Violence, as well as an Associate with Holcomb + Ward, LLP.

Formerly, he was Legislative Counsel with the ACLU of Georgia, and Counsel with the Campaign to Keep Guns Off Campus. An out immigrant formerly on public assistance, and once wrongfully flagged as a non-citizen voter, he became a social worker and then, after graduating from Yale, an attorney.

Among his proudest contributions, he has: challenged Georgia's [voter ID and proof of citizenship laws](#) (as a party), and later [corrupted electronic voting machines](#) (as an attorney) in court; fought in legislature against, then originated lawsuit to [challenge campus carry](#) after it passed; advocated and published extensively [against the use of religion to discriminate against women and LGBT people](#); conceived now-state law allowing [survivors of domestic violence](#) to terminate leases; created **ESL-job development** course for **refugee and immigrant** clients of **Catholic Charities Atlanta**; and promoted voter registration statewide, as board member of 159 Georgia Together. He is also a Fulbright Scholar, and Term Member of the Council on Foreign Relations.
