Michael Wu is Chief Legal Officer and Corporate Secretary of Madewell, a leading denim and casual apparel company.

Before joining Madewell in 2019, Michael was the Senior Vice President, General Counsel and Secretary of Carter's, Inc. (NYSE: CRI), the largest young children's apparel company in North America. Michael joined Carter's in 2014 and was responsible for legal and government affairs, compliance, internal audit, risk management and corporate social responsibility at Carter's.

Prior to Carter's, Michael was general counsel and corporate secretary of Rosetta Stone Inc. (NYSE: RST), an education technology software company. He joined Rosetta Stone in 2006 and established Rosetta Stone's anti-piracy and anti-fraud enforcement programs. Michael oversaw the company's successful initial public offering on the New York Stock Exchange in 2009 and the acquisitions of Lexia Learning, Livemocha, Tell Me More and Vivity Labs.

Before joining Rosetta Stone, Michael was vice president and general counsel at Montreal-based Teleglobe International Holdings Ltd. (Nasdaq: TLGB), an international telecommunications provider. Michael led Teleglobe's acquisition of voice over IP provider, ITXC Corp., the listing of Teleglobe on NASDAQ in 2004 and the sale of Teleglobe to the Tata Group in 2006.

Prior to Teleglobe, Michael was a senior attorney in the Hong Kong and Reston, Virginia offices of Global One, an international joint venture between Sprint, Deutsche Telekom and France Telecom. He was also associated with Baker Botts LLP in Houston, Texas and a firm in Washington, D.C. that merged into Morgan Lewis.

Michael serves on the advisory boards of the Georgetown Law Corporate Counsel Institute and the Asian American Bar Association of New York. Michael is also a member of the Georgia Asian Pacific American Bar Association board of directors.
