Prior to Rosetta Stone, Michael was Vice President and General Counsel at Teleglobe International Holdings Ltd., an international telecommunications provider. Michael led Teleglobe's acquisition of ITXC Corp., the listing of Teleglobe on NASDAQ in 2004, and the sale of Teleglobe to the Tata Group in 2006.
