Judge Justin S. Anand has served as a United States Magistrate Judge in the Northern District of Georgia (Atlanta Division) since June 2012.

Previously, Judge Anand served as an Assistant United States Attorney in Atlanta for over eight years and was the Deputy Chief of the Economic Crimes and Cybercrimes Section. He prosecuted and supervised the prosecution of securities, corporate and health care frauds and other white-collar cases. He prosecuted several high-profile Atlanta-based Ponzi schemes and stock pump-and-dump schemes. Judge Anand was a frequent speaker at events in the Atlanta legal community on topics including white collar criminal prosecutions, bank fraud, and securities fraud prosecutions and investigations.

Before serving as a prosecutor, Judge Anand was in New York City with the leading Wall Street law firm of Cleary, Gottlieb, Steen & Hamilton. His trial and arbitration-based practice focused on securities, corporate governance, mergers and acquisitions litigation, and Governmental investigations and white-collar cases. He also worked on a variety of matters including patent and copyright infringement cases, international contract disputes, and defense of foreign sovereign nations and state-owned instrumentalities in U.S. and international commercial litigation. Judge Anand served as a law clerk for U.S. District Judge Jed S. Rakoff, S.D.N.Y.

Judge Anand graduated from Swarthmore College and from Harvard Law School, from which he graduated *magna cum laude*.
