AAPI Crime Victims & Education Fund Press Launch

WHO: On the six-month anniversary of the March 16 shootings, the AAPI Crime Victims & Education Fund will hold a press conference to announce the formation of its national advisory board and initial corporate donors. Families of the March 16 shooting victims will be in attendance.

WHAT: The announcement will include a fundraising update for families and survivors of the March 16 shooting, and new efforts focused on creating a \$1 million fund to support future AAPI crime victims and education efforts nationally.

WHEN: Thursday, September 16 from noon to 1:00 p.m. Eastern.
